In 2018, a press release stated that AutoCAD is the leading CAD program in the world, with more than 38 million licensed users as of 2016 and a market share of 45.6%.^[1] It was the top-ranked consumer-focused software by the Dimensional Analysis, Engineering and Architecture group at the 2019 Gartner Magic Quadrant for Integrated Product Engineering & Maintenance

Applications. In August 2018, the U.S. Army awarded Autodesk a \$5.2 billion contract to produce a new combat vehicle designed around the Redstone missile-launching system.[2] The Army chose the AutoCAD platform, saying it is the best available technology.[3]

History The first AutoCAD was released in 1982 as a desktop app running on microcomputers with internal graphics controllers. Developed by N. McGovern and M. Lydell, Jr., two developers who

worked on a previous generation of AutoLisp, the first AutoCAD program ran on the Apple II computer. The Apple II version of AutoCAD came at a low price and could be run directly on the Apple IIs original internal display. Users would interact with the program in much the same manner as they would with a line drawing on paper, by simply moving a cursor and clicking on mouse buttons. Users could choose the way the cursor moved by switching between the arrows

on the keyboard or selecting a preset path. The price at the time was about \$800.[4] In 1983, N. McGovern and M. Lydell, Jr. were joined by J.L. Fanning, then an Autodesk employee and developer of the first AutoLisp graphics library.[5] Between 1983 and 1984, they continued to develop the first AutoCAD. Autodesk started testing the new application with users in 1983, and by the end of 1984, the first version was released to the public. The early versions

included a basic function set, including common features found in previous CAD programs. This included editing line segments and lines, editing curves and drafting the basic components of a drawing. As the program evolved, features were added to AutoCAD to provide additional functionality, such as the ability to copy and paste drawings to create complex layouts. Although not intended for large-scale production, Autodesk has said that AutoCAD is

intended for small projects by individual users.[6] In 1986, Autodesk introduced AutoCAD LT. Originally sold
