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For a few years, it was also the state of the art in construction engineering software. Its use grew and spread from the United States and Canada to Europe and Asia, with a particularly strong presence in the Middle East and South Asia. Today, it's a cornerstone of the digital infrastructure of most industries, from architecture and civil engineering to manufacturing and transportation. By the end of 2003, Autodesk's flagship application AutoCAD Product Key had achieved sales of almost \$1 billion, accounting for about 40% of the company's revenue. That same year, Autodesk's stock was acquired by Rupert Murdoch's 21st Century Fox, and the company's CEO, Barry Robbins, retired in 2004. The years since have been turbulent for Autodesk, with the company going through multiple management changes and undergoing a round of restructuring that resulted in two major layoffs and the elimination of several offices. 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Most of the other drawing tools are either in the form of tools or stand-alone applications. Support for AutoCAD's DXF importing and exporting is included in version 9, and is based on the APPICS standard for automated drawing exchange. DXF importing has been further refined in Autodesk Exchange Apps. In 1999, Autodesk released a successor to AutoCAD called AutoCAD R14, which added the ability to create 3D models. This function requires a DVD or CD-ROM drive. Also in 1999, version 11 (AutoCAD R11) introduced an Extensible Markup Language (XML) import feature.

This functionality is not needed in AutoCAD LT, which only supports importation of drawings created by other AutoCAD products and Microsoft Office. In the 2000s, the ability to import and export DWG files in the "group drawing" format was added. Group drawings are based on the DXF format and allow for the design and storage of complex geometric forms.

AutoCAD 2006 introduced the ability to share drawings with other users and open them up for editing. AutoCAD 2008 introduced the ability to create 2D drawings that are shared in the web. AutoCAD 2009 introduced the ability to create 3D models. AutoCAD 2010 introduced the ability to work with 3D drawings that were created by other users.
